What's The Snack Pack Program?



The Snack Pack Program is an initiative that collects food items for local children that might have a limited supply of food over the weekend. School counselors, social workers, staff and teachers identify the needs of Sumter County Elementary School Children.

Currently the Snack Pack Program serves over 425 children in need of weekend food supplementation to the following Sumter County Elementary Schools.

The Snack Packs are given out to select students every Friday for weekend food supplementation. The Snack Packs contain 7-9 items that are individually wrapped, small bags and small cans/containers.
